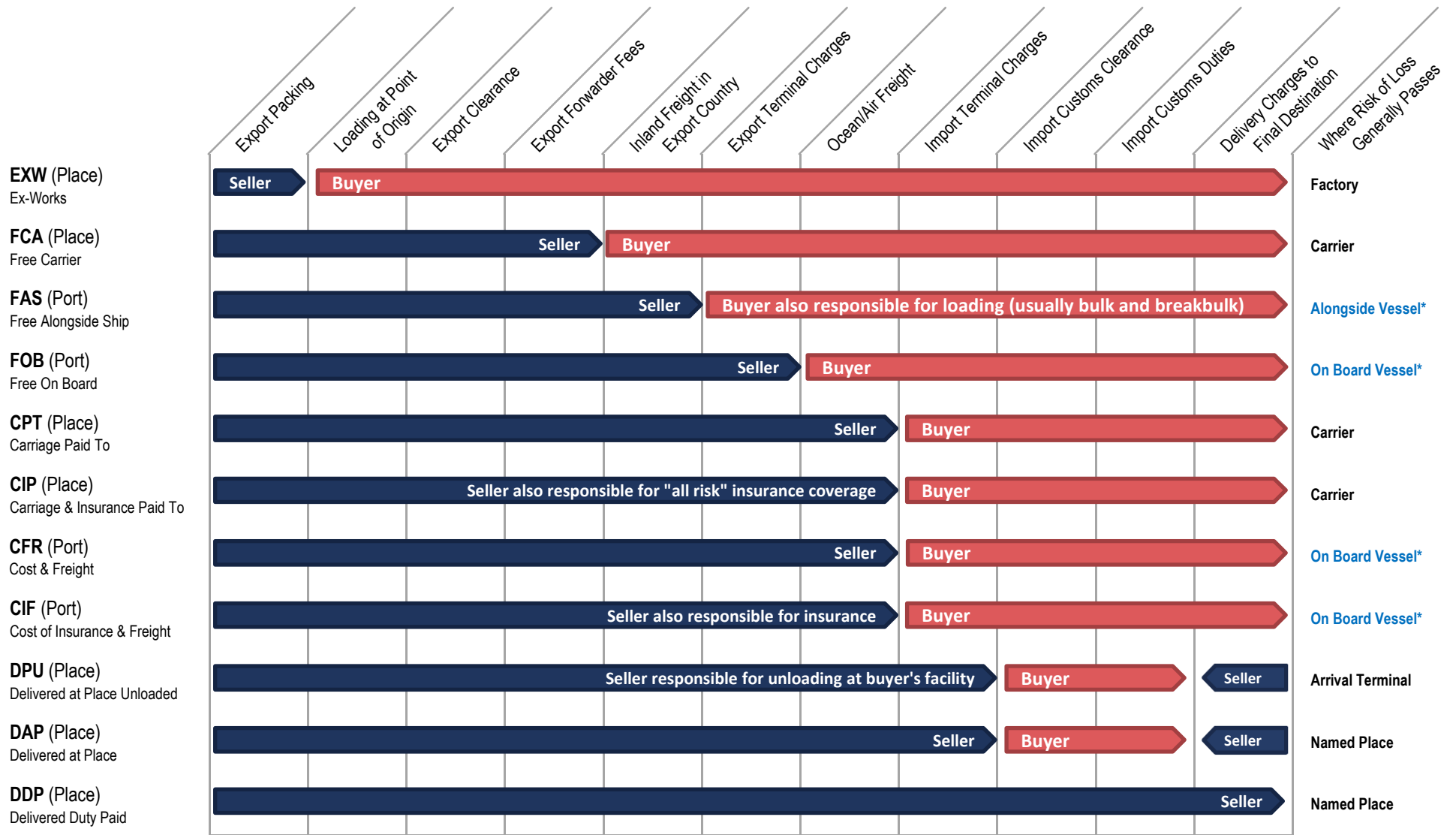

OCEAN CONTAINER GUIDE

Sizes below are for typical ocean full container load equipment. Actual cargo specification and how cargo is packed and loaded in container will determine which container equipment should be used.

Note: Actual container sizes vary by carrier and manufacturer. Other equipment types and sizes may be available depending on carrier & trade lane. The information provided in the above table should be used for estimation purposes only.
